The Students@Work program provides the opportunity for students to have exposure to a large global organisation in their local community. Broadspectrum is part of global company called Ferrovial who is based in over 20 countries and employs more than 96,000 people.

Across multiple sites Broadspectrum provides Estate Maintenance and Operation Services including Estate Upkeep and Land Management, Hospitality and Catering.

The Students@Work program takes place at Puckapunyal Military Base and is open to any Year 10 and 11 students from Seymour College, St Mary's College, Seymour Flexible Learning Centre and GOTAFE.

The program offers a group of students the opportunity to:

- Work within a global company
- Work in a team
- Develop new skills
- Improve communication presentation and people skills
- Enhance CV content and gain valuable work related skills
- Get a taste of the real world of business first hand
- Be involved in the day to day operations of a real Defence base.

The selected students will work on a set task for one week and will present their work to an audience at the conclusion of the program.

















About the Program:

The students will work, as a team, on a project that will have a strong safety focus, e.g. examining methods used to communicate safety matters to employees.

At the end of the week the students will submit their work and give a presentation to Broadspectrum and Defence personnel, teachers from their schools, family and friends.

Throughout the week a Broadspectrum Manager and Program Facilitator will supervise the students.

Who Can Apply?

Opened to students in Years 10 and 11 (must be 16 years of age or older) attending Seymour College, St Mary's College, Seymour Flexible Learning Centre or GOTAFE.
