Students complete a job application letter and CV, then participate in a simulated job interview with an industry volunteer. This builds confidence, and they receive feedback from their interviewers to assist them in their preparation for the 'real thing'.

Design Thinking **Year Levels: 9-11 | Cost: Free**

Industry Tours and Immersion Workshops **Year Levels: 7-12 | Cost: Free**

Tours and workshops provide opportunities for staff and students to meet with business representatives in their workplace and explore the many training and employment options within the Industry through interactive engagement. Running across all 4 Terms.



Project Ready **Year Levels: 10-12 | Cost: Fee for service**

Project Ready is a one-year work readiness program incorporating a VET Certificate II in Active Volunteering. The program is compatible with the new Vocational Major and helps students prepare for the transition from secondary school to the workforce.
